What does 2002 hold for us. Only God knows.

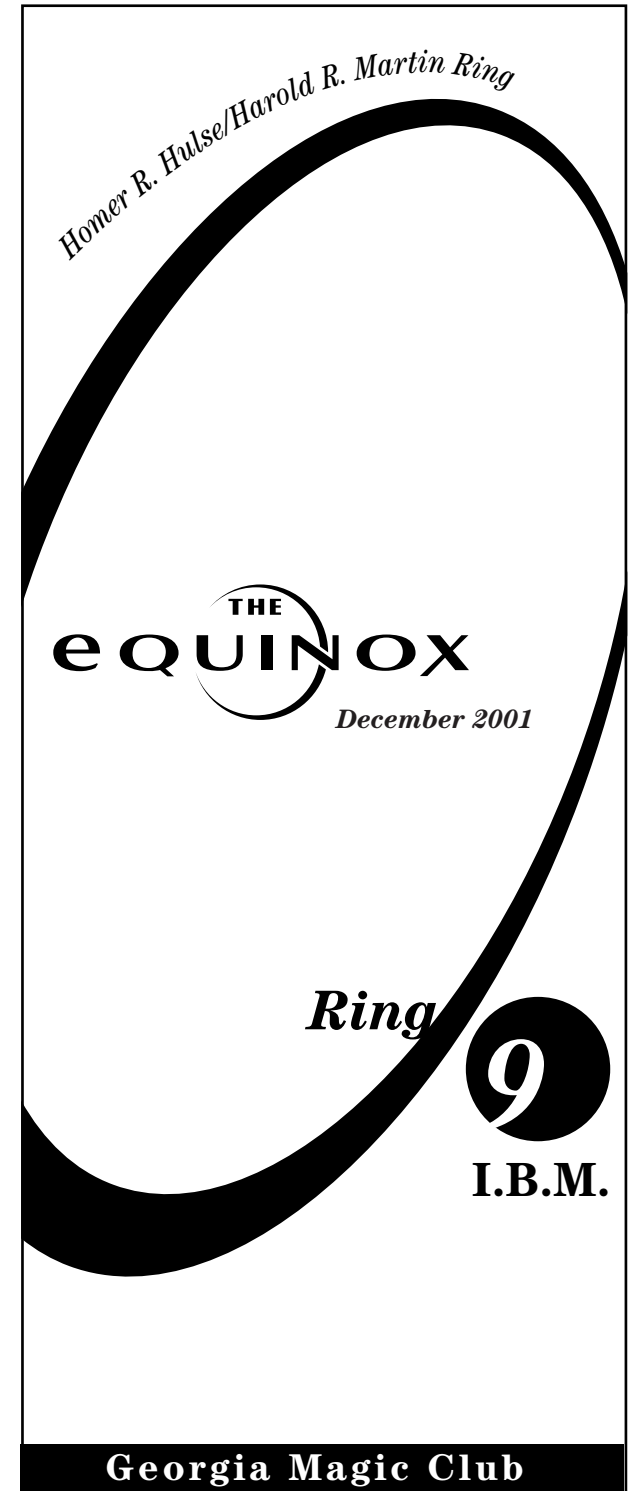

*Mt. Vernon Presbyterian Church*

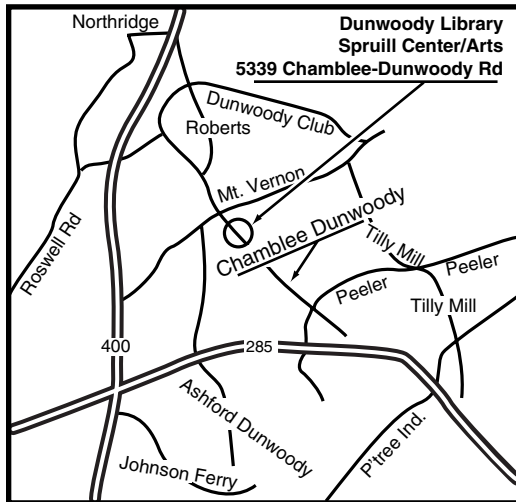
Dinner will start at 7:00 and the show starts at 8:00pm.

### Harry Allen of Daytona Magic

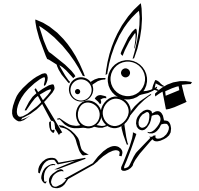
