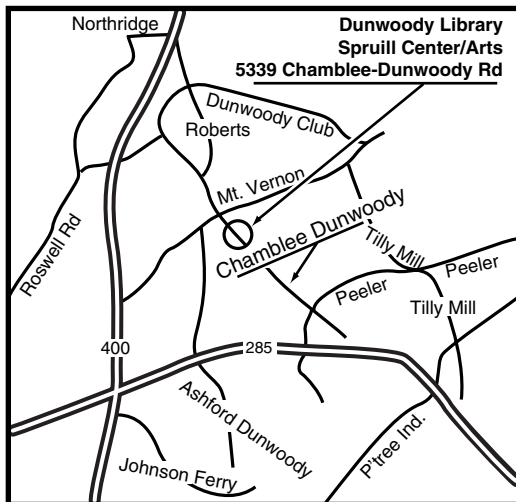

Two Simple Ways to Make Your Mailings More Effective

- Use commemorative first-class stamps rather than metered mail or standard-issue first class stamps. This makes the envelope look less like junk mail.
- Include a P.S. at the end of your letter to restate an important point or to call for action. It may be trite, but the postscript is among the most-read parts of a sales letter.
