Count My Many Blessings (They're in there somewhere)

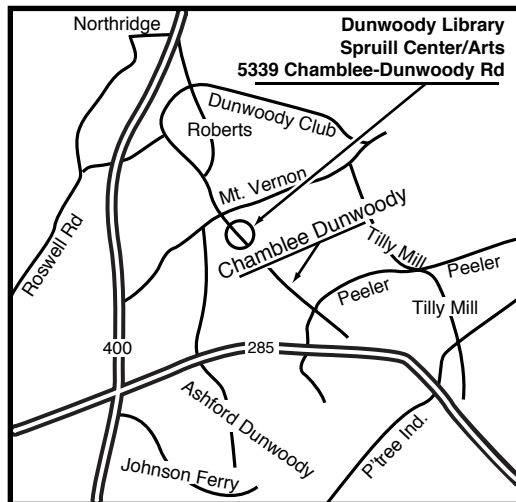
There is a new book entitled *Count My Many Blessings (They're in there somewhere)* by a local author many of us know, John Stanfield. In his book John recalls growing up in an often-impooverished family during the Great Depression. He tells his story in a humorous style. It is as if you were having and in depth discussion of what it was like for him as he grew up. There are many highlights. One gets to see how he came to discover the art of magic as a young boy and what it meant to him.
